
Dear Mr. Weisshaus:

Dear Mr. Duffy,

I have received your letter dated August 3, 2012 regarding my pending request for records of communication between the two governors of New York and New Jersey and the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey over the recent increase in toll prices. You indicated in your letter (for the eighth time), that an extension is needed until August 13, 2012 to comply with my request.

I understand that your office may be overwhelmed with the work of record production made in response to the multiple requests your office has received. Nevertheless, I am a bit puzzled that it is taking you close to eleven months to comply with my request. I believe this wait period to be unusually long.

I HEREBY REQUEST that any further requests for extension indicate the reason/s why it is taking more than 11-months to comply with my records request. In addition, I HEREBY REQUEST that you identify the status and progress of where your office is presently in complying with the above captioned request.

If you decline to comply with this request, I request that you cite the exact code of law upon which the refusal is based.

I appreciate you taking the time to review this letter and conduct a records search. I am looking forward to hear from you soon.
